

# October rides



**Sun 1 Oct – New developments, planned buildings and other urban changes. A Bristol Civic Society guest-lead ride (Easy - 12 miles)**

**Meet 9:45am at Arnolfini, BS1 4QA. Finish 1pm**

An easy paced stop-start ride in and around the City looking at some major developments and planned buildings and changes in the urban fabric of Bristol. Demolition of old BRI building, new student accommodation blocks, Nelson St changes, University of Bristol new £300m Temple Quarter campus, plans to pedestrianise Tyndall Avenue, and others. Bring an open mind and be prepared to discuss whether these will harm or benefit our city!

**Sun 8 Oct – Willsbridge Valley Nature Reserve (Medium – 20 miles)**

**Meet 9:45am at Arnolfini, BS1 4QA. Finish 3pm**

A leisurely ride to this oasis of wildlife hidden amongst modern housing estates and once the site of milling, quarrying and a coal dramway. We follow the Bristol-Bath Railway Path on the way out, returning down Conham Hill through Crews Hole along the banks of the river Avon.

**Sun 15 Oct – Portishead Riviera (Medium - 25 miles)**

**Meet 10:15am at Blaise cafe, Kings Weston Rd, BS10 7QS. Finish 3pm**

A gentle paced ride to this fast-expanding and popular seaside resort. This sociable ride will follow off-road cyclepaths and quiet roads where possible, and will take a leisurely pace to enjoy the scenery.

**Sun 22 Oct – Tyntesfield Estate (Easy – 15 miles)**


**Meet 10:45am at the Water Tower, Durdham Downs, BS9 1FG. Finish 3pm**

We will cross Clifton Suspension Bridge to take a woodland route through Leigh Woods Nature Reserve, and on to Abbots Pool. Following quiet roads through Lower Failand we descend to the visitor centre at Tyntesfield estate. After an early lunch we return to Bristol along the Festival Way. There will be some fairly easy off-road sections and some walking on this ride.

**Sun 29 Oct – Unsolved Bristol Murders (Easy - 14 miles)**

**Meet 12:45pm at Arnolfini, BS1 4QA. Finish about 4pm**

This stop start ride will tour round the city visiting sites linked with unsolved murders of the past.
